<b>Distance to a Bus Stop Location</b>	1 of 1

<b>Policy</b>	The Sudbury Student Services Consortium will assign central bus stops for students, in an effort to minimize the length of ride times.
<b>Operational Procedure</b>	<p>Students may be required to walk the following distances to and from their bus stop:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Junior and Senior Kindergarten - 0.25 km</li><li>• Grades 1 to 3 - 0.5 km</li><li>• Grades 4 to 8 – 0.8 km</li><li>• Grades 9 to 12 – 1.25 km</li></ul> <p>Certain circumstances may require longer walking distances to bus stops, such as cul de sacs and dead end streets.</p> <p>The distances measured will be the shortest walking route along road or maintained walkways from home property to stop location. The Sudbury Student Services Consortium, using transportation software with the appropriate municipal map, will make all measurements for transportation purposes.</p> <p>Bus stop locations should be a minimum of 300 metres apart and should allow a minimum of 150 metres of clear vision in both directions. Bus stop locations should not be located on a steep grade, brow of a hill or a blind curve. All stop locations are subject to conditions under the <i>Highway Traffic Act</i>.</p> <p>It is the responsibility of parents or guardians to ensure that young students are accompanied to and from these locations.</p>
