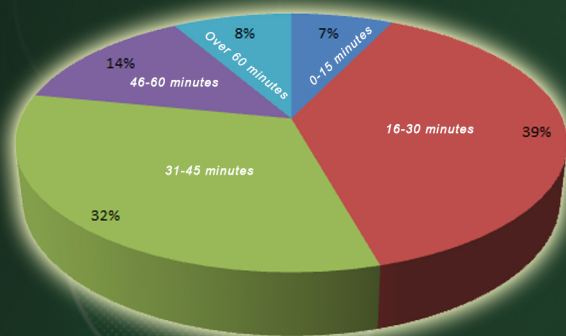

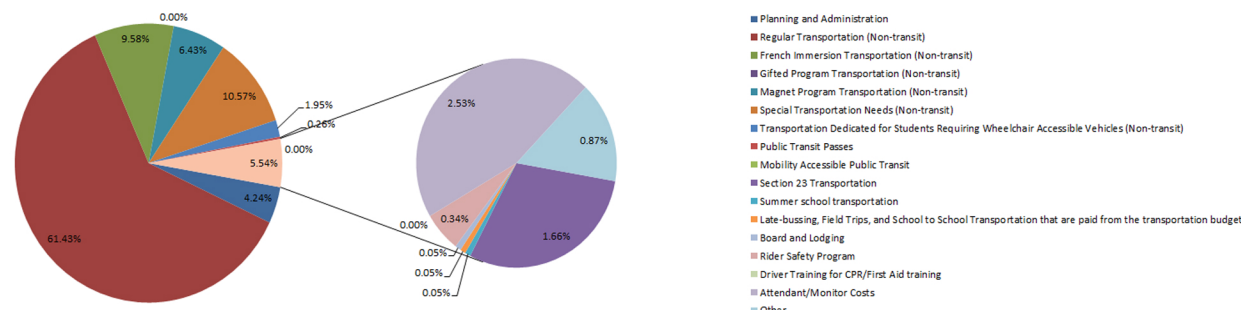

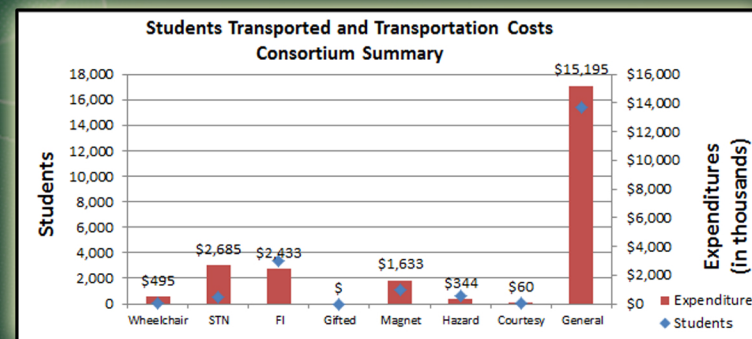
Distribution of Transportation Expenditure

Costing Summary



There is a total of 407 school bus running everyday in the Sudbury, Espanola and Manitoulin Districts.

In 1969, approximately 50% of children walked or bicycled to school. Today, fewer than 15 percent walk or bicycle to school.

The average school bus transports 54 student passengers, replacing approximately 36 family vehicles.

We transport over 21,000 students to school everyday and 947 of those students have more than one address.
