• <u>Sitter/Daycare Address</u>

The sitter/daycare transportation address will be utilized as the grandfathered address when a student is transported to and/or from this address at the time of the boundary change.

This address will be grandfathered for this particular student only.

When the student changes sitter/daycare or no longer requires daycare services, the sitter/daycare address will no longer qualify under this provision. The student's residence address will not qualify for transportation under this provision and the eligibility policy will apply.
