| <b>Policy</b>   | In accordance with <i>Ontario's Highway Traffic Act</i> , the Sudbury Student Services Consortium is responsible to ensure that school bus vehicles that are equipped with integrated seats, five-point harnesses and seatbelts are used in accordance with the manufacturer's recommended maximum weight limits as well as with Bill 73 – <i>An Act to Enhance the Safety of Children and Youth on Ontario's Roads</i> .   |  |
| <b>Operational Procedure</b>                                  | <p>The Sudbury Student Services Consortium will assign the following seats:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• When available, the built-in restraint system with a 5-point harness will be assigned to students who are in Junior or Senior Kindergarten. When these are unavailable, these students will be assigned to 3-point passenger seatbelts;</li><li>• When available, the 3-point passenger seatbelts will be assigned to students who are in Kindergarten to grade 12.</li><li>• The manufacturer's recommended maximum weight for the built-in restraint system with a 5-point harness is 22 to 85 lbs.</li></ul> <p>According to the Highway Traffic Act, "no person shall drive on a highway a motor vehicle in which there is a passenger who is under 16 years old unless, that passenger occupies a seating position for which a seat belt assembly has been provided, and is wearing the complete seat belt assembly as required."</p> <p>School bus monitors will be trained to assist students assigned to integrated seats (five-point harness) and/or 3-point passenger seatbelts. In the absence of school bus monitors, students, parents, guardians and/or schools will be responsible of ensuring students are secured in their 5-point harness or seatbelts.</p> <p>Students who do not remain secured in their five-point harness seats and/or seatbelts will receive an infraction report and may lose their transportation privilege.</p> |  |
